TO: MEMBERS OF THE OREGON STATE BOARD OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND THE WESTERN OREGON UNIVERSITY BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Because the Western Oregon University Board of Trustees will assume all statutory authority over Western Oregon University ("WOU") on July 1, 2015, the State Board of Higher Education and the WOU Board of Trustees will meet in executive session jointly to interview candidates for the institution's new president. This call-to-meeting letter is designed to provide public notice for both boards to meet in executive session.

The boards will meet in executive session pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes ("ORS") 192.660(2)(a) to consider the employment of a public officer or employee. Pursuant to ORS 192.660(4), representatives of the institutionalized news media are allowed to attend, but the board requires that the discussions and any reports received in the executive session be undisclosed. Pursuant to ORS 192.660(6), no final action will be taken or final decision made in the executive session.


