The WOU Board of Trustees will meet on Wednesday, November 17, 2021. Prior to the meeting, the Board will host a "Coffee Chat" to provide the campus community an opportunity for informal conversation. Coffee and refreshments will be available in the Werner University Center (WUC), Ochoco Room from 9:00-9:30am.

The Board will meet in executive session beginning at 9:30am in the WUC, Santiam Room. The board will meet pursuant to ORS 192.660(2)(d) (to conduct deliberations with persons designated by the governing body to carry on labor negotiations). The media is not authorized to attend the executive session pursuant to ORS 192.660(4).

Following the executive session, the Board will reconvene for the public meeting in the WUC, Columbia Room at which time the Board will consider, and potentially act, on the following matters: acceptance of the June 9, 2021 and September 10, 2021 meeting minutes; acceptance of the FY2021 Management Report (as of September 30, 2021); acceptance of a revision to the EGTC charter; ratification of a contract with Education Advisory Board; approval of a new BA-BAS degree in Data Analytics; approval of the fiscal year 2022 budget. The board will also receive stakeholder updates from ASWOU, Faculty Senate, Staff Senate, SEIU, and WOUFT. President Kenton will provide an update report and facilitate a discussion regarding enrollment and tuition rates.

Following these discussions, Anthem Executive will join the Board for a conversation to gather input regarding characteristics, experiences, and traits it would like to see in WOU's next president.

Public comment will be offered to the Board in two different methods. Any person may sign up at the meeting to offer comment in-person. Conversely persons interested in offering virtual (telephonic) public comment may complete this <u>form by noon on Tuesday, November 16</u> to be included. Public comment will adhere to the <u>Board Statement on the Conduct of Public Meetings</u>. Specifically, the Board may hear from one person per topic per organization for up to three minutes. The Secretary will provide persons included on the roster for telephonic comment with the information and protocol necessary to call in to the Board meeting.
