FRESHMAN

- ✓ Get familiar with Degree Tracks and consult with your CJ faculty Adviser each term
- ✓ Take Introduction to CJ (CJ 213D)
- ✓ Take Research & Writing About Social Justice Issues (CJ 267C) Preregs: CJ 213D & WR 122
- √ Take GenEd (General Education) FYS courses

JUNIOR

- ✓ Meet with your adviser & begin to discuss practicum
- ✓ Complete the Practicum application. Practicum Requirement: 2.67gpa OR consult with your adviser to discuss your options
- ✓ You may complete your practicum this year or your senior year (Plan ahead, finding and securing a placement can take time)

SOPHOMORE

- ✓ Meet with your CJ Adviser each term
- ✓ Choose a minor if desired (not a university requirement)
- ✓ Continue taking your CJ core classes and LACC's
- ✓ Complete a CJ Profile Form before you complete 90 credits and transition to your permanent adviser in consultation with the CJ General Adviser
