

Local Banking Information

Although it may not be a requirement, many international students choose to establish an account with a bank in the United States. It is especially helpful to have a local bank account if you plan to work on campus or would like to pay bills by check. Inquire directly with the bank to determine which kind of account will work best for your needs.

In general, the items that you will need to set up a local bank account are:

1. Your local mailing address in the United States
2. WOU ID card
3. Passport
4. DS-2019
5. Money to deposit
