CORNELL NOTETAKING SYSTEM

1. First Step - PREPARATION

- Use a large, loose-leaf notebook.
- Use only one side of the paper.
- Draw a vertical line 2 1/2 inches from the left side of you paper. This is the recall column.

3. Third Step – AFTER THE LECTURE

- Now use the column.
- Jot down ideas or key words which give you the idea of the lecture.

2. Second Step – DURING THE LECTURE

- Record notes in paragraph form.
- Capture general ideas, not illustrative ideas.
- Skip lines to show end of ideas or thoughts.
- Using abbreviations will save time.
- Write legibly.

- 4. Fourth Step OVERVIEW
- Summarize the entire lecture in your own words.
- Create a paragraph that covers the entire lecture that you can use as a reminder as you study.
