# University Technology Advisory Committee -- Kyler Dreyer, VP of Staff Senate

- The committee is in its infancy; no current bylaws; only meets once a month; will have a sub-committee model and the sub-committees will meet more often to bring initiatives to the larger committee
- Ellucian mobile--should be testable this month; people can download the app to test it;
- Windows 10 updates: Windows 7 will no longer be supported; computer labs will be upgraded Summer 2019; things people can do to assist UCS in this is to contact them with times they can come update; if people have special software, they should contact UCS to have them test it on Windows 10
- LMS subcommittee to evaluate our continued use of Moodle; cost-benefit analysis of what to assess with other LMSs
- Recommendation: uninstall Flash on computers
- Testing group: we don't have a testing plan yet
